Youth Category Explanation

2D Painting: oils, acrylics, watercolor, tempera, etc.

2D Drawing: chalk, charcoal, pen and ink, pastels, pencils, wax crayons, etc.

Printmaking: transferring ink from a prepared surface onto paper or fabric to create original works.

2D Mixed Media: incorporates more than one category/medium (paint, pastel, paper, pen, etc.)

2D Collage: made of various materials (paper, cloth, wood, etc.)

Photography: prints made from the artist original image

Digital: the use of computers to create and edit traditional work

Ceramics: original functional or sculptural clay or porcelain work

Sculpture: (3D work in any medium)

Functional Art: Stain glass, furniture, woodwork, fibers (quilting, needlework, etc.), jewelry, etc.
